



In Zimbabwe, pastors are among the most vulnerable.

Under lockdown, where church attendance is prohibited, ministers whose survival depends on weekly donations can no longer support themselves and their families. Overnight, many are going hungry.

Because of your gift to the Emergency Covid-19 Appeal, nearly a hundred pastors and their families now have food and masks.

By supporting leaders, your generosity reaches out even further.

Your gift means that these vital community leaders can get back to work on the front lines of the crisis, disseminating hygiene information, coordinating community efforts to combat the virus and providing counselling to families.



And that's the beginning of what your gifts make possible...

At relief camps in India for example, hundreds are supported through your generosity, receiving safety kits consisting of masks, soaps, sanitizers and meal kits with staples like rice, oil, potatoes, milk and bread. Over 1900 marginalized people living in Angola, including seniors and people with disabilities, have received life-saving food, too.





invitation tips...

→ face to face – peer to peer

Be authentic. Talk about outcomes of Mission & Service or changed hearts or why you care about what the person cares about.

→ small groups

Gather in small groups for coffee and conversation about Mission & Service.

→ repeat invitations

Tell the stories of Mission & Service and invite people to make a meaningful gift for Mission & Service regularly.

thanking tips

- → Acknowledge the gift quickly & explicitly: What exactly was given, and for what? Describe the impact of the gift.
- → **Connect** with givers. Send thank you cards or make phone calls to special and new givers. Say thank you often in communications like newsletters and social media
- → **Share** the certificate of thanksgiving sent to your community of faith.
- → Give United Church crest lapel pins as a thank you for special gifts.
