November 1/21	2021-2022/ #9	<p><b>Restoration of Pastoral Relationship of Reverend Lawrence Moore with Kinosao Sipi Keenanow</b></p> <p>Having received a request from the <b>Reverend Lawrence Moore</b>, dated July 8, 2021, requesting a change in pastoral relations from <b>Kinosao Sipi Keenanow</b> (Norway House), which was accepted by the Pastoral Relations Commission of the Prairie to Pine Regional Council on August 10, 2021 (Motion 2021-2022 # 6 F with notes for clarification in the minutes of September 14, 2021 - Motion 2021-2022 # 7 A);</p> <p>and having subsequently received a request from the Reverend Lawrence Moore, dated October 8, 2021, retracting his request for a change in pastoral relations, and asking to continue in the pastoral relationship, and having received some comment from Ida McKay, on behalf of the Community of Faith, supporting the request to continue;</p> <p>and having received comments from conversations between Aileen Urquhart, Pastoral Relations Commission Liaison and Ida McKay, representing the Community of Faith, and between Tim Hackborn (Office of Vocation) and Lawrence Moore,</p> <p>the Pastoral Relations Commission of the Prairie to Pine Regional Council of the United Church of Canada:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. receives correspondence from the Reverend Lawrence Moore, retracting his request for a change in pastoral relations, dated October 8, 2021;</li> <li>ii. restores the Reverend Lawrence Moore’s pastoral relationship with Kinosao Sipi Keenanow (Norway House) effective November 1, 2021, with terms previously approved</li> <li>iii. commits to following up with the governing body of Kinosao Sipi Keenanow (Norway House) early in 2022 regarding discussions with the community, Council and Lawrence Moore concerning support for his ministry.</li> </ol> <p style="text-align: right;"><b><u>Carried</u></b></p>
	2021-2022/ #10 (A and B)	<p><b>Request for change in pastoral relations</b></p> <p>A. Having received the minutes of a meeting on October 30, 2021 of the Community of Faith at <b>Kildonan United Church</b> (Winnipeg), chaired by Mary Best, Chair of the Pastoral Relations Commission of the Prairie to Pine Regional Council, who had also attended a meeting of the Council of Kildonan United Church on October 5, 2021 to discuss the matter; and having received a copy of correspondence from the <b>Reverend Mark Satterly</b>, which was read at the meeting on October 30, 2021 (in accordance with Section</p>

I.3.1.6d of *The Manual*), the Pastoral Relations Commission of the Prairie to Pine Regional Council of the United Church of Canada:

- i. approves the ending of the pastoral relationship between the **Reverend Mark Satterly and Kildonan United Church** (Winnipeg), effective January 31, 2022, due to declining financial resources;
- ii. concurs with the terms and timelines approved at the meeting on October 30, 2021 of the Kildonan United Church Community of Faith as follows: the Reverend Mark Satterly to be given a combination of some advance notice and salary and benefits in lieu of service. Specifically, that the last day worked by the Reverend Mark Satterly will be November 13, 2021, after which time the Reverend Mark Satterly will be paid until the end of the notice period (January 31, 2022) and released from exercising the functions of ministry related to his position a Minister of Kildonan United Church;
- iii. and note that a service marking the ending of the pastoral relationship be arranged for a date before January 31, 2022, mutually agreed upon by the Reverend Satterly and the Council of Kildonan United Church, and arranged through Mary Best, Chair of the Pastoral Relations Commission of the Prairie to Pine Regional Council and /or the Pastoral Charge Supervisor

*Note: Other motions were approved at the meeting on October 30, 2021 of the Kildonan United Church Pastoral Charge, placing the building up for sale and moving toward disbanding the congregation at a date after January 31, 2022, and after the sale of the building.*

- B. Having been informed of consultation between Judy Hare, Pastoral Relations Minister, and the Reverend Mark Satterly, and between Judy Hare and the Council of Kildonan United Church, the Pastoral Relations Commission of the Prairie to Pine Regional Council approves the appointment of the Reverend Don Schau, Minister at Atlantic-Garden City United Church (Winnipeg) as Pastoral Charge Supervisor at Kildonan United Church (Winnipeg).
